Peter Woodward showed a 1/72 scale Great Wall Brand, F-15 Eagle. Mostly OOB, but he added Remove Before Flight Tags and aftermarket decals. A very nice work.

Steve Bacon showed a 1/72 scale Dragon Panther V. He added Zimmeritt and tracks from the Revell Panther. He showed, as well, a 1/35 Soviet KV2 from Trumpeter, with aftermarket parts and Zimmeritt. It was painted as a German allied Russian Volunteer Force. Purely what if, but nicely done. Steve lastly had a WIP 1/144 scale Me109 G-10. He may finish it soon.

Jim Philhower showed a 5.5CM prototype Flak system from 10.6 Co in 1/35th scale resin kit. He also showed a well done Trumpeter BTR60 in 1/35 scale. It proved a complex build and was finished as an Iraqi vehicle from the 1980's.

Lance Sellers brought in a 1,400's era 54mm Knight figure from Superior Models. The figure was kitted out wearing transitional armor.
